Some observations

- » Massive progress
- »Best progress is when Senior Managers are behind the use of technology
- »So many now provide free WiFi access
- »Many are buying small banks of tablets
- »Keen to have staff development
- »Some have developed Moodle or using free platforms



What are providers doing?

- Mobile learning »Sound Recorders on mobile phones for speaking and listening assessment and professional discussions
- »Cameras for supporting evidence
- » Facetime for assessment
- »FS tutor using camera and recorder for speaking and listening evidence
- »Skype for assessor-learner meetings
- » Video for assessment

- »Family Learning tutor has been using Aurasma and QR codes linking to videos and animations (on the VLE), teaching parents phonics so they can support children
- »In a gardening session, held in a local park, learners with learning difficulties and disabilities used tablets very effectively to record and evaluate progress

Learner surveys

- » One ACL service has amended its PCDL learner follow-up survey which now includes questions about the kit used during the course and how it helped their learning
- » Another asks if they have computer skills to use government and social websites and this is being developed to better reflect and evidence the use of ICT
- » Another doesn't focus on the use of technology, more around the kit, learning resources and the work room.
- » Most don't ask but some are considering developing their surveys to include these topics
